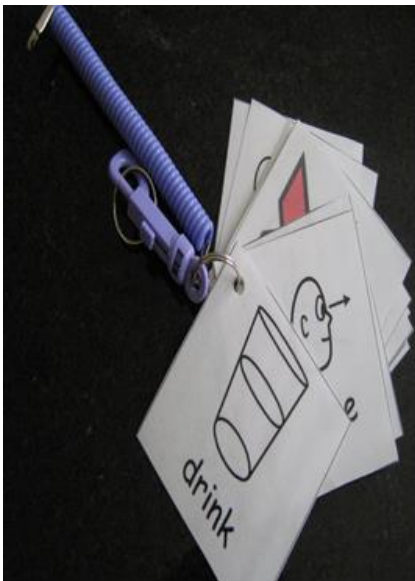




## Communication and Autism Team (CAT)

### Picture Keyrings



Keyrings help you to communicate simply what is happening in your day with your child.

They can be a small selection 6-8 of regularly used photos or symbols that can be kept with you for instant access when required.

They are particularly helpful as an immediate visual cue about what will happen next.

They are good for times of changes in the day such as moving from one activity to another, such as stopping play for lunch.

They can also be used to reinforce behaviour expectations such as stop and sit.

Keyrings can be made physically by taking pictures and putting them on a key ring.

Or they can be in a folder on your phone(s) and or iPad.
