


La Noche de Brujas

Halloween es un día festivo que se celebra en los Estados Unidos y en varios otros países del mundo. Se llama la Noche de Brujas en español. Siempre se celebra el último día de octubre, es decir, el 31 de octubre. Este día se asocia con los colores anaranjado, negro y morado. El símbolo de la Noche de Brujas más reconocido es la calabaza iluminada.

Al principio del mes de octubre se puede ver varios huertos de calabazas por la ciudad. Las familias suelen visitar a los huertos para elegir y comprar una calabaza grande. Al llegar a casa, los padres ayudan a los hijos a vaciar y tallar un rostro en la calabaza. Al amanecer se pone una vela dentro de la calabaza y así se convierte en una calabaza iluminada.

La Noche de Brujas se coincide con la temporada de la cosecha de las manzanas cada año. Por eso una de las comidas más conocidas en las fiestas de "Halloween" son las manzanas acarameladas. Estas manzanas se hacen cubriendo las manzanas con una capa de azúcar. La capa de azúcar más común es la hecha de azúcar, jarabe de maíz, agua, canela y colorante rojo.


